



Total 40 NSS students and volunteers took part in the program and gained knowledge about the values and moralities of mother tongue. Dr.Nibedita Bayen talked about language which originates in a specific socio-cultural milieu as the first identity marker. It plays a key role in shaping the personality of an individual, his thought processes, and larger view of the life and world around. The language we first learn is the one that is used at home. Mother is the first to speak to the child and his/her interlocuter for almost all the time. This language, which is passed down through parents and grandparents is the mother tongue. At the moment, the solution for this crisis is to encourage and motivate the speaking of mother tongue constantly among the younger generation. When a person is well versed in their mother tongue in today's connected world, it becomes easier to communicate and engage with the world in general and grow wonderful ideas that can lead the world from the front.


