**A COMPREHENSIVE REPORT

SUMMARY

P. R. Thakur Government College, in collaboration with Chandpara Rural Hospital, successfully organized a Free Health Check-Up Camp on January 5, 2026 on the occasion of the observation of Students' Week, 2026. The camp was held at the college's Seminar Hall and commenced at 11:00 AM. This initiative aimed to provide accessible healthcare services to the college community, promoting health awareness and early detection of medical conditions.

1.2 Objectives

The primary objectives of organizing this medical camp were:

1. To provide free health check-up facilities to the students, faculty members, staff members.
2. To promote health awareness and preventive healthcare practices.
3. To facilitate early detection of common health conditions.

4. To strengthen the collaboration between educational institutions and healthcare providers.
5. To fulfil the social responsibility of the institution towards community welfare.

2.BRIEF REPORT

The event was meticulously organized in accordance with the official notification on 24th December, 2025 bearing Reference Number PRTGC-25/183, which allowed adequate time for comprehensive coordination between P.R. Thakur Government College and Chandpara Rural Hospital, encompassing identification of healthcare requirements, coordination with the hospital for medical personnel and equipment, venue arrangement, communication and publicity, and preparation of registration systems. The organizing committee, comprising college authorities, faculty members, administrative staff, and student volunteers, worked collaboratively to ensure seamless coordination between the college and hospital teams, with the partnership with Chandpara Rural Hospital proving instrumental in providing professional medical services through their contribution of qualified medical personnel, equipment, and expertise that demonstrated a strong commitment to community health initiatives. The Seminar Hall was appropriately arranged to accommodate various health check-up stations including a registration desk, waiting area, separate consultation areas for different health assessments, adequate seating arrangements, and proper lighting and ventilation, where the medical team from Chandpara Rural Hospital, comprising qualified doctors and paramedical staff, offered comprehensive health screening services such as vital signs monitoring (blood pressure, pulse rate, temperature), blood sugar testing, general physical examination, and referral services for advanced treatment when required. The medical camp was open to the students of P. R. Thakur Government

College from all semesters as well as teaching and non-teaching staff, with participants being systematically registered at the entry point where basic information including name, age, gender, contact details, and primary health concerns was collected to ensure proper documentation and enable follow-up possibilities.

Student volunteers who participated in organizing and facilitating the medical camp shared overwhelmingly positive feedback about their experience. Students from different departments and semesters appreciated the opportunity to interact with medical professionals and understand the practical aspects of healthcare delivery. Many students expressed deep satisfaction in contributing to community welfare and making a meaningful difference in people's lives. The experience significantly enhanced their understanding of public health challenges and the importance of preventive healthcare. Given the impact on both their professional development and community well-being, students enthusiastically recommended organizing similar events more frequently to benefit both the community and future volunteers.

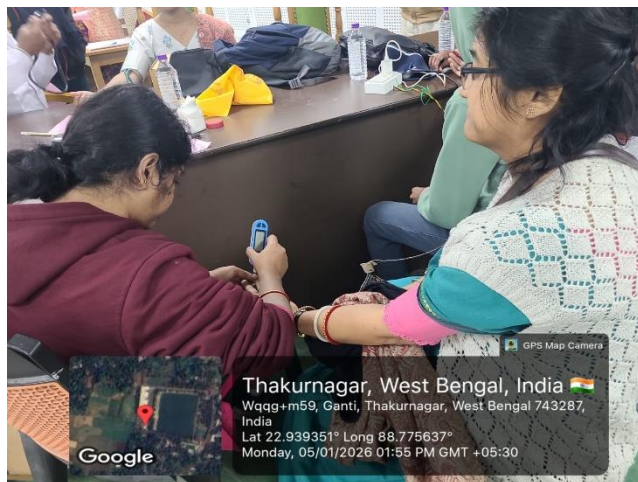
4. CONCLUSION & RECOMMENDATIONS
