REPORT ON THE OBSERVANCE OF "DR. SYAMA PRASAD MOOKERJEE FORTNIGHT" (from 23rd June to 6th July, 2026)

A. Introduction

In compliance with Office Notice No. PRTGC-26/76 dated 19.06.2026 issued by the Office of the Principal, P.R. Thakur Govt. College observed the "Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee Fortnight" (পঞ্চকালব্যাপী ড. শ্যামাপ্রসাদ মুখোপাধ্যায় স্মরণ অনুষ্ঠান) from 23rd June, 2026 to 6th July, 2026. The fortnight was observed through a series of academic activities and competitions aimed at acquainting students, teaching and non-teaching staff with the life, ideals and contributions of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee.

B. Objective

The observance was organised with the objective of introducing students to the life, philosophy and nation-building contributions of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee, and to encourage academic engagement through competitive and creative activities such as essay writing, quizzing, reading sessions and poster-making.

D.1. Report on Essay Competition

Event 1: Essay Competition on "Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee's Life and Philosophy"

As part of the "Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee Fortnight" observed in accordance with Notice No. PRTGC-26/76 dated 19.06.2026, an Essay Competition was organised on 23rd June, 2026 at the Central Library. The competition, held on the theme "Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee's Life and Philosophy," aimed to introduce students to the ideals, vision and contributions of Dr. Mookerjee to nation-building and education.

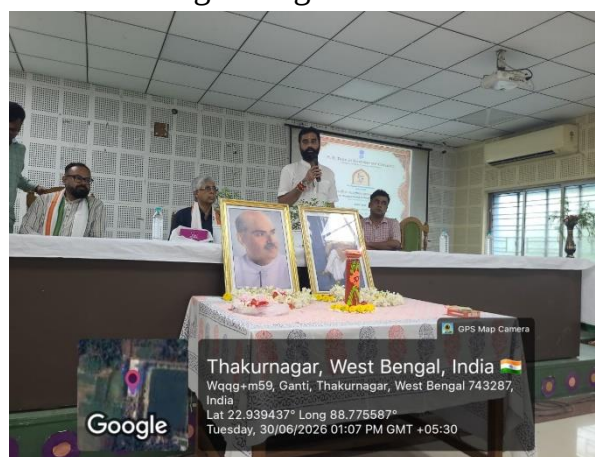

The Programme was well attended by students, teaching and non-teaching staff, and concluded successfully, furthering the objectives of the fortnight-long observance.



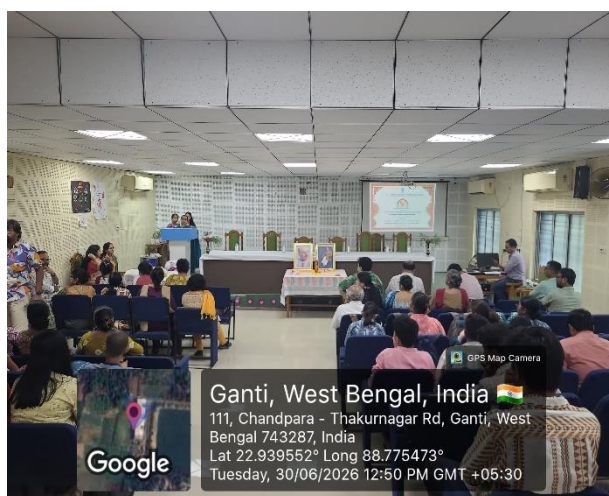

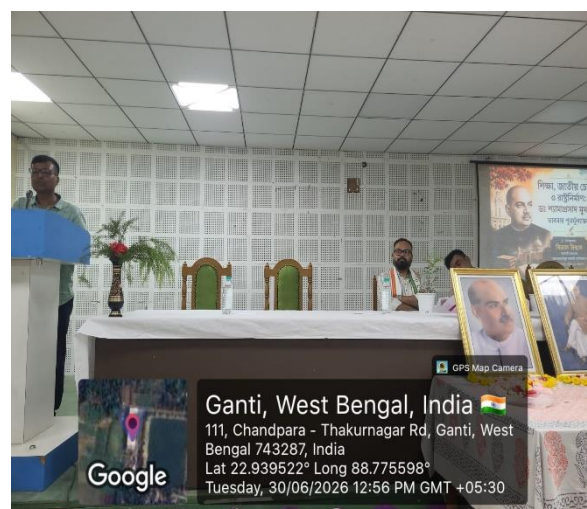

Event 3: Poster Competition and Exhibition on the theme "Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee: Life and Contributions"

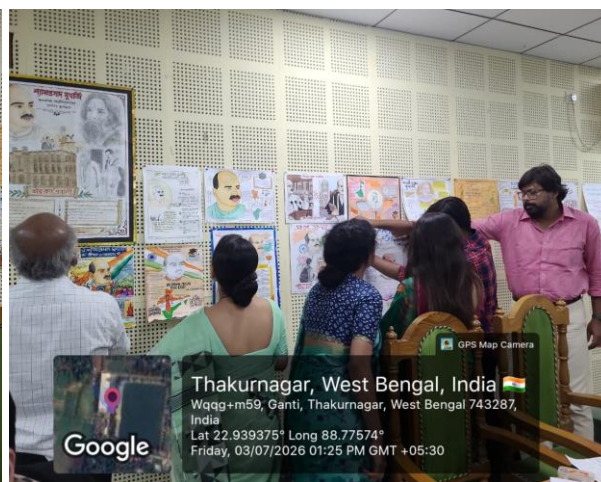
Date & Time: 3 July 2026, 12:15 pm onwards

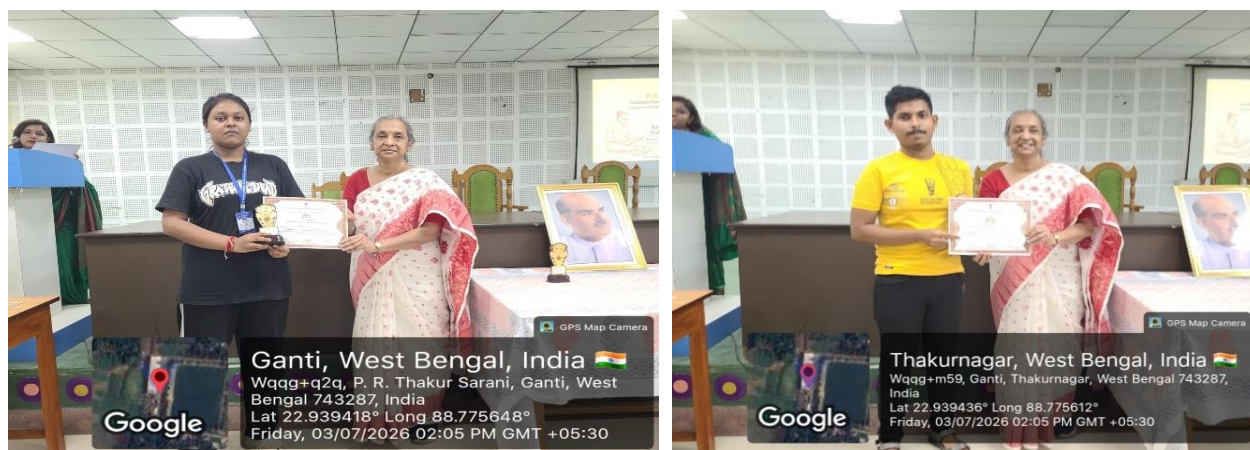
The programme brought the fortnight-long observance to a fitting close, reflecting the sustained engagement and participation of students, teaching and non-teaching staff throughout the series of events.

D.4. Report of the observation of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee's 125th Birth Anniversary held on Monday, July 6, 2026 at Guruchand Kaksha, P.R. Thakur Govt. College

Event: Reading Session on Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee's Writings and Speeches, followed by **Quiz Competition** on His Life and Work

Date & Time: 6th July 2026, 11:30 am onwards

Venue: Guruchand Kaksha, P. R. Thakur Govt. College

In accordance with the directive issued by the Chief Secretary to the Government of West Bengal vide Order No. 3187-ICA(N) dated 23rd June 2026, and further communicated through Memo No. ED-138/2026 dated 1st July 2026 by the Director of Public Instruction,

West Bengal, all Government and Government-aided colleges across the State were called upon to observe the 125th Birth Anniversary of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee on 6th July 2026 (Monday) in a befitting manner, with regular classes suspended for the day to enable full participation in the commemorative programme. In faithful compliance with these directions, and as the culminating event of the fortnight-long observance already underway at the college, P.R. Thakur Govt. College organised a Reading Session on Dr. Mookerjee's writings and speeches, followed by a Quiz Competition on his life and work, on 6th July 2026 from 11:30 am onwards at Guruchand Kaksha.

The Reading Session was conducted by the students from various departments with the specific objective outlined in the State Government's directive of promoting awareness among the younger generation regarding Dr. Mookerjee's contribution to education, public service and nation-building. Students, teaching and non-teaching staff gathered to listen to and reflect upon excerpts from his own writings and public addresses, gaining first-hand insight into the depth of his thought on education, cultural identity and the intellectual and political history of the nation to which he devoted his life. This was followed immediately by a Quiz Competition centered on his biography, philosophy and achievements, in keeping with the Government's specific action point calling for essay, debate and quiz competitions in higher educational institutions as part of the State-wide celebration. The competition drew enthusiastic participation from students across departments, who competed in a spirited yet cordial atmosphere while reinforcing the knowledge gathered through the earlier events of the fortnight, including the essay competition, memorial lecture and poster exhibition.

The programme held at P. R. Thakur Govt. College on 6th July 2026 formed part of a much larger, coordinated State initiative, undertaken pursuant to Cabinet Decision No. 27 dated 3rd June 2026, to commemorate Dr. Mookerjee's legacy through year-long celebrations across all districts and educational institutions of West Bengal. This broader initiative encompasses district-level observance committees, public outreach through libraries and museums, heritage and memorial initiatives such as the preservation of associated sites and digitisation of archival records, and the encouragement of academic research and publication on his life and work. Viewed within this wider context, the Reading Session and Quiz Competition organised by the college were not an isolated event but a local contribution to a State-wide movement aimed at strengthening public engagement with West Bengal's historical and intellectual heritage.

The event concluded successfully, bringing to a close the fortnight-long series of academic activities organised in memory of Dr. Syama Prasad Mookerjee, and reaffirming the college's commitment to honouring his legacy in line with both institutional initiative and the directives of the Government of West Bengal. 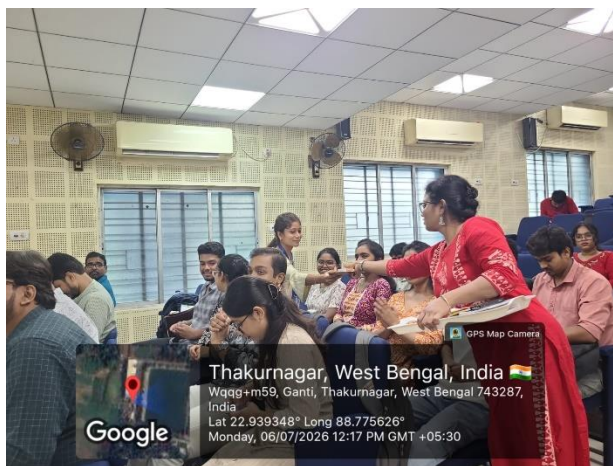

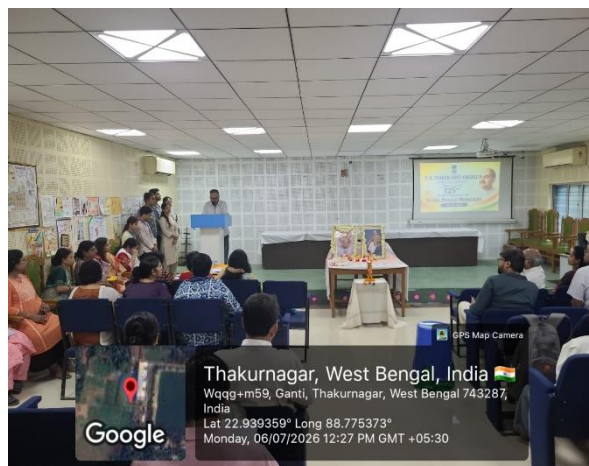

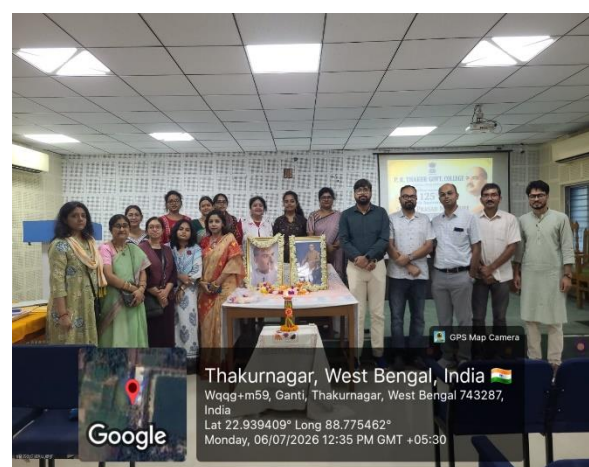
