Observation of Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign-2026

P. R. Thakur Govt. College celebrated the Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign-2026 (9th August, 2026 –17th August, 2026) as directed by the Education Directorate, Govt. of West Bengal vide memo no. ED-161/2026 dated 28th July, 2026 and by Information & cultural Affairs Department vide memo no. 2091(75)/Secy/ICA/2026 dated 24th July, 2026 through various events.

The Har Ghar Tiranga Campaign-2026 at P. R. Thakur Govt. College commenced on 10th August, 2026 (Monday). The NSS unit of the college conducted the programme, which started with the National Anthem sung by all NSS volunteers, students, and teaching and non-teaching staff, following the flag hoisting by the Officer-in-Charge of the college. As part of an ongoing commitment to fostering community awareness and national spirit, the NSS Committee of P. R. Thakur Govt. College organized an awareness rally in observance of the “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign. The rally started from the college campus and proceeded towards Thakurnagar Railway Station.

Participants were organized into two groups:

Cycling Group: Students who owned bicycles brought them and led the rally at the front.

Walking Group: All other participating students followed the cycling group on foot.

The rally aimed to promote awareness within the college and surrounding community about the “Har Ghar Tiranga” initiative, encouraging a spirit of patriotism and civic participation among students and staff. NSS volunteers, the general student population, and members of the teaching and non-teaching staff chanted slogans like "Vande Mataram" and "Bharat Mata ki Jai" during the rally.

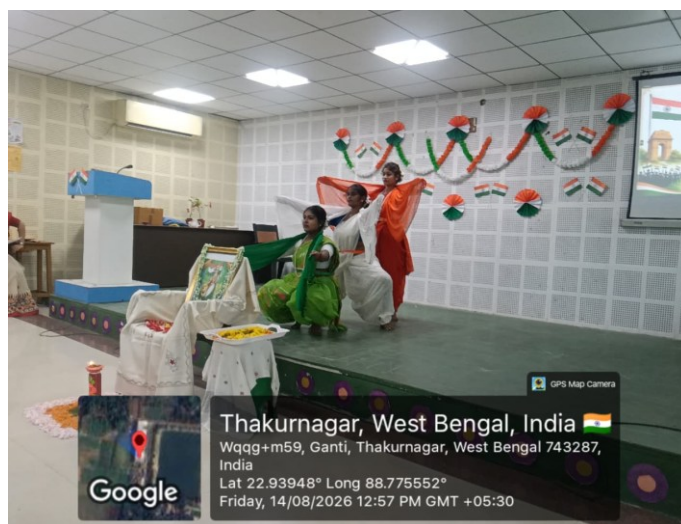
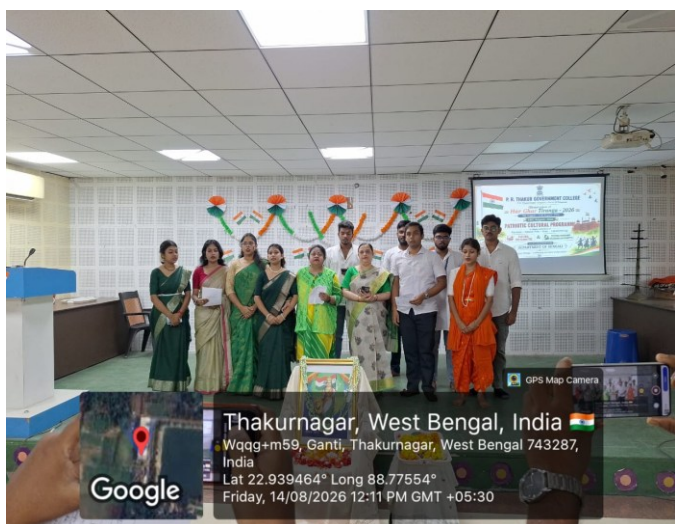

Glimpses of Yoga Session on 11th August, 2026 conducted by VAC-II implementation sub Committee of P. R. Thakur Govt. College)

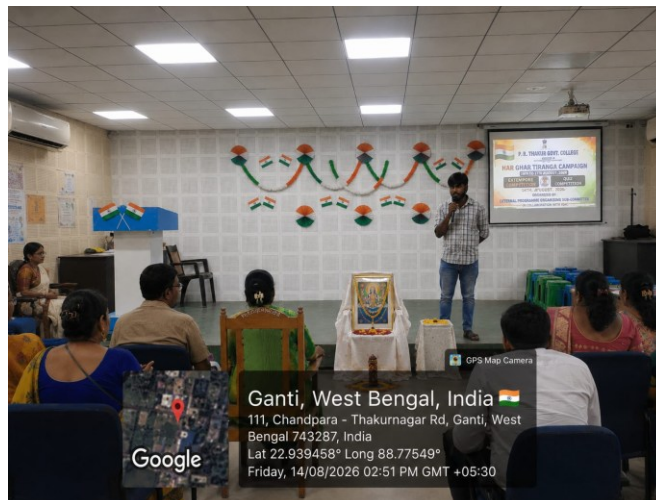
